- 1. Fr. James Guirguis provides several reasons why attending the right church matters. Please provide two of those reasons?
- 2. Why does the author quote Acts 8 and the story of the Ethiopian eunuch? Give four examples the author mentions regarding the modern issues that churches argue about.
- 3. There are over 38,000 Christian denominations. According to the author, explain the historical origin of these denominations? Describe the logical argument and the verse which the author quotes to suggest that this confusion shouldn't have existed?
- 4. What are the reasons that led Martin Luther to have conflict with the Roman Catholic Church and what new doctrine about the Bible did this lead to?
- 5. According to the author, give two examples of the modern issues that churches argue about because it is easy to be confused when reading the bible.
- 6. According to the author, why do we have to be ready to use sources besides the Bible?
- 7. To follow the words of the Lord Jesus that says "the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking beautiful pearls", the author suggests to become treasure hunters in search of fine pearls. How can we do that?
- 8. According to the author, explain what is one of the best ways for us to understand what we call "the mind" of the early Church? Describe how this way is not 'a leap' from our practice today?
- 9. When were the first books of the New Testament written? When was it that the New Testament as a complete work compiled and accepted by the Church? Who officially named all the books of the New Testament, while rejecting many that were not considered authentic or instructive for the salvation and life of a Christian?

- 10. What is the verse in 2 Thess 3:6? What resource does the apostle Paul refer the faithful to? According to the author, explain the difference between this resource and the epistle St Paul wrote?
- 11. The earliest Christians didn't look to the New Testament to answer their questions. What could be the two main reasons for this? What was the authority for the early Christians that was referred to in 1Tim. 3:15? Describe how the author uses both the written and unwritten in 1 Tim. 3:15 to explain this authority.
- 12. The Great Schism refers to the first major split of the Christian Church.
- a. Name all the great centers of Christianity at the time of this schism (p29)
- b. What became of these great centers after this great dispute and what are they known as now?
- 13. Martin Luther pushed Christians to firmly believe in sola fide. What do these words mean? Please provide at least two verses that they use to defend such a claim. (p34)
- 14. Regarding salvation by faith, what is the teachings of the Protestants about faith versus works in our eternal salvation?
- 15. Eph. 2:8-9 says "For by grace you have been saved through faith and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast". This verse states that we are saved by the grace of God, but verses like this present only half the truth Describe how the author explains this using his example.
- 16. What is the example of the wealthy banker referring to and what argument is the author making?
- 17. According to the Orthodox Church, what is the Christian life? Explain the definition as it relates to god's grace?
- 18. According to the author, explain the teachings of the Orthodox Church about Christian life and God's grace? How did God show his grace?

- 19. According to St Paul in (1Tim 4:10b) Jesus Christ is "...the savior of all men, especially of those who believe" the Lord writes the check and we have to make a decision to accept it or not. - 22. In light of St Paul's epistle to the Philippians, what does it mean to be an Orthodox Christian? Support with a verse from the epistle? How does St Peter confirm the timeline in his general epistle?
- 23. Explain (3) possible reasons for what the author describes as 'fast-food faith'
- 24. According to St. John Chrysostom, why is it not enough to believe in the son in order to have everlasting life?
- 25. According to St. John Chrysostom, why is it we are not all saved "if salvation is by grace [Rom 11:6]"?
