Evening & Morning



1. The Thanksgiving Prayer



- Every prayer starts with thanking the Lord.

(Eph. 5:20) "Giving thanks always for all things unto God "

- The priest stand outside God's door prostrates as a humble request that God accept his prayers, for himself and the people - bareheaded.

2. The Mystery of Incense

5 spoonful of incense.

1. Abel [offer the 1st born].
2. Noah [offer of every pure animal, bird].
3. Melchizedek [bread & wine].
4. Aaron [offer sacrifices for himself & his people].
5. Zacharias [offer incense in the sanctuary].

The priest goes around the altar 3 times with censer (silently praying)



3. The major Litanies



- **Pm Incense + am.SAT.**

The Litany of the departed (the Reposed)

- **Am Incense**

The Litanies of the sick (except Sat.)

The travelers (except Sun./ Feasts) w/o Oblations

The offering (@ the altar facing E)

- The priest offers incense while the congregation recites:
The Gloria - The Trisagion - Hail to you - The doxology
The introduction to the Creed - The Creed.

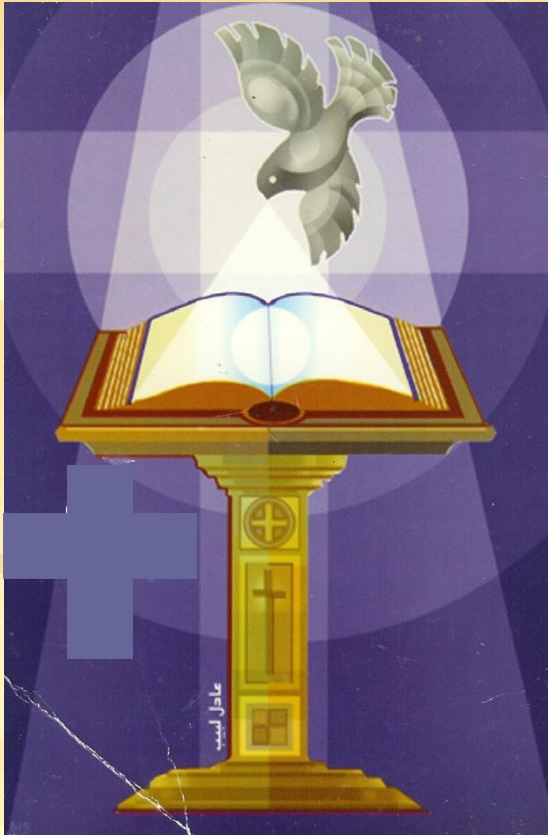

"Lord, now You letting Your servant depart in peace."

7. The 5 minor Litanies

Peace : *Remember, O Lord, the peace of Your one,... Church.*

Lord have mercy

Fathers: *Remember, O Lord, our blessed ... Papa abba Shenouda the III and his spiritual brothers.*

Lord have mercy

Holy places: *Remember, O Lord, the salvation of this Yours holy place.*

Lord have mercy

Waters, Plants, Fruits: *Graciously accord, O Lord, to bless ...*

Lord have mercy x3

Assemblies : *Remember, O Lord, Assemblies, ...bless them.*

Lord have mercy

+ But let Your people be in blessing 1000's...

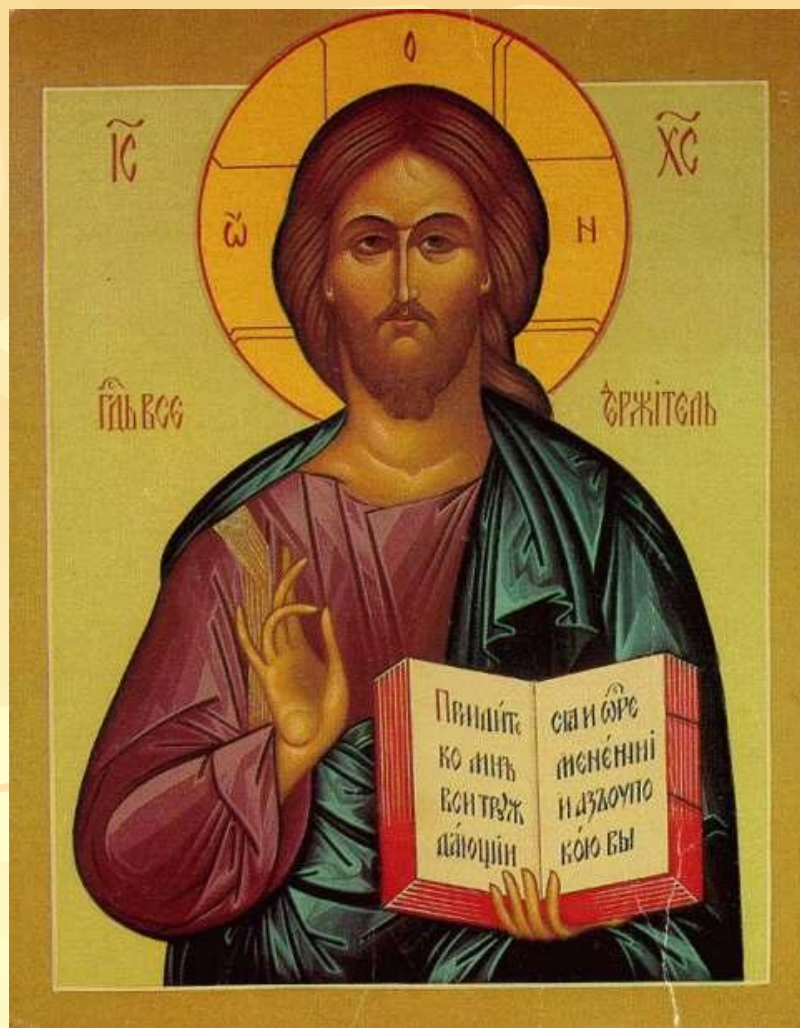
8. The 3 Absolution & Submission

The Divine Liturgy

The Preparatory

The priest recites inaudibly:

*Lord, Who knows the hearts of all, Who is Holy, and
Who rests amid the saints ... that I may begin, ...*

- 1. Clergy dressing.
- 2. Altar preparation
(Clothing the Altar)
- 3. The prayer of the hours.
- 4. Priest washing his hands.

The Preparatory

1. Clergy dressing:

The priest make the sign of the  on his/deacons garments.

Praying Ps.29 "I will exalt You, O Lord for You have lifted me up"

Ps.92 "The Lord reigns, He is clothed with majesty"



2. Altar preparation (Clothing the Altar):

Unwrapping of the utensils (Corporate, Paten, Star, Chalice, Spoon)





3. The prayer of the hours:

Non-fasting 3rd/6th ~ **Fasting** 3rd/6th/9th ~ **Feasts**
none.

4. Priest washing his hands **3X** :



1st (Ps. 50:7) "Purge me with hyssop and I shall clean"

2nd (Ps. 50:7) "Make me to hear joy and gladness"

3rd (Ps. 25:6,7) "I shall wash my hands in innocence"

- 1. Selection of the Lamb.
- 2. Baptism of the Lamb, wrapping the Lamb, cross on the Lamb. "Glory & Honor"
- 3. Burial of the Lamb.
(Purling the wine / water
Abrospherin & Seal)
- Servant Absolution.

The Catechumen

Readings from the Katameros:

1. The Pauline Letters

[1st rounds of incense during the reading of the Pauline] (3X+1return)

2. The Catholicon

[No round of incense]

3. The Book of Acts (The Praxis)

[A second round (3X) of incense during the reading of the Praxis]

4. The Synaxarium

The Prayer
of the Veil

Asking
Forgiveness



Inaudibly: O God,... we pray & entreat Your goodness ... that this mystery - for washing away of our sins - not be unto condemnation.

Three Long Litanies for:

1- The Peace. "Again, let us ask ... the peace of Your ... church..."

2- The Fathers. "Again ... We ask and entreat Your goodness, ... remember O lord, our honored patriarch ..."

3- The Assemblies. "Again, let us ask ... our assemblies ... Bless them."

4. The Liturgy of the Faithful

Start with the reciting of the Creed

1. The prayer of Reconciliation
2. The Anaphora (Lifting up of hearts)
3. The prayer of Institution
4. The 7 Litanies
5. The Commemoration of the Saints
6. The Fraction prayer
7. The Confession of the priest / deacon
8. Communing - Washing the Utensils

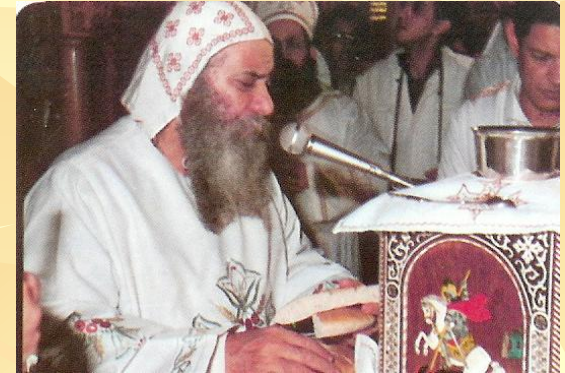
